



18th Annual Art on the Green 2023 24-hour Live Sculpting & 2D Competition

Competition Dates: August 18-19, 2023 Application Deadline: postmarked by July 7, 2023

General Rules & Information

2D & 3D competitors will provide:

- a. The armature, base, and heating device for clay sculptures.
- b. The easel, canvas, paint/pencils, brushes and matte or frame (to display the final work)
- c. Individual light source (i.e. table lamp)

The City of Green River will provide:

- a. Clay 20 lbs
- b. A protected area (building and/or tent)
- c. A work area approximately 4' X 10'
- d. A work surface 30" X 6' table and chair
- e. A 30" x 6' space or table to display and sell your table size artwork

Competition Rules:

- 1. 3D pieces using clay provided by GRAC may not exceed 16" in height, 20" in length, and 20" in width; 3D pieces using media provided by the artist may be any size deemed appropriate by the artist. These pieces must fit on a table, stand or easel and be easily moved for judging. Two Dimensional pieces may not exceed what will fit on an easel that is provided by the artist. Size of the pieces for 2D competition should also include the frame. This is an individual competition, all sculpting and/or drawing/painting will be done by the artist (no helpers).
- 2. The entire 2D or 3D piece must be completed and professionally displayed in the given time allotted in order to be judged. (24 hours)
 - a. Artist is prohibited from signing their work until after the official judging has concluded.
 - b. Competition work may NOT leave the premises. If the work of art leaves the artist will be disqualified.
 - c. Artists' may only submit **one** piece of work for the competition, or specific arrangements must be made with the Green River Arts Council.
 - d. All 2D & 3D art must be 1st time pieces. (Original work no copies)
 - e. Only the armature that will be used for the competition may be pre-built
 - f. Pre-built parts for the sculpture are not permitted
 - g. Only hand tools are allowed for the competition
 - h. An under-drawing/painting in neutral colors may be pre-drawn
- 3. Approved reference materials:
 - a. Artist's own sketches
 - $b.\ Photographs$
 - c. Multiple image sources
 - d. Artist maquette
- 4. Prohibited reference materials:
 - a. Photographs of other artists' work
 - b. Other artists' copyrighted material

July 14- Artist packets mailed

July 21- Digital biography and photo must be received to be included in promotional items

August 18 – Mandatory Artist Meeting 10:00 am, Expedition Island Pavilion

- 5. Artists will be allowed to bring art for display and sale, and submit pieces for the silent auction (table top size only).
- 6. Artwork created at the competition may be sold through a silent auction process following the competition.

A 20% commission of all sales during the competition will be collected by GRAC.

The Green River Arts Council reserves the right to refuse the display of artwork which is not family oriented.
