8:00 AM on Saturday, November 18, 2023.

Pool play begins - Saturday, November 18 at 8:00 AM; Tournament resumes with bracket play at 8:00 AM on Sunday, November 19

- <u>Saturday Pool Play</u> Pool play will be a single round-robin with all teams advancing to the championship round. Specifics are listed at the bottom of each Score Sheet. Matches will consist of as many games as possible playing as many teams as possible to help you be super sore by Sunday bracket play when it really matters. In the event of ties for advancement to the elimination rounds or for seeding, the first tie-breaker will be head-to-head records, the second will be total points for and against (% of difference) in head-to-head, and the third will be a coin flip.
- <u>Championship Rounds</u> The championship round will be double elimination with winner's bracket matches consisting of the best 2 out of 3 games. The first two games to 25 points and the tie-breaker game (game 3) will go to 15 points.
- All teams must provide officials (referee and umpire), line judges, and scorekeepers per the schedule. The Green River Parks and Recreation
 Department will give a whistle to each team in their team packet. If a team fails to referee a match for which they are scheduled, they may
 be eliminated from future tournament play or be required to forfeit their next game.
- Good sportsmanship and observance of Green River Recreation Center rules will be required. Players may use the Recreation Center throughout the tournament based on regular hours of operation. Spectators are free to watch the tournament but must pay admission to the Recreation Center if they intend to use the facility. Women's and Men's lockers cost \$1.00 a day for rental. **PLEASE respect the host facilities and the team you represent by taking care of your trash and cleaning up after yourself.
- <u>Gym Shoe Policy</u>: Shoes worn in from the street are <u>not</u> allowed on the playing surface of the gymnasium. Please carry your shoes into the facilities. Thank you for your cooperation.
- <u>PLAYER ELIGIBILITY</u>: All players must be at least 15 years of age by Saturday, November 18, 2023, and must be included on the roster which is submitted and finalized before your first match. Roster forms are available in your team packet. No roster additions will be allowed after this time without permission from the tournament director. Players will be required to show proof of age and identification, if the opposing team protests, to the referee prior to the end of the match.
- When playing with 3 or fewer players, at least one of those players must be female. A team may have no more than 3 men on the floor at the same time. When the ball is played more than once by a team, at least one of the contacts shall be made by a female player. there is no minimum number of players to play a game. However, one player must be female. There is also no **designated** rotation of play by gender except what has been stated above. There is no set serving order.
- Due to safety concerns for the children and patrons, children must remain seated in the bleachers and be supervised by a non-participating adult at all times. Children 8 years old and older may be in the spectator area without an accompanying supervisor but will be expected to remain seated at all times.
- Protest must be voiced to the referee and settled immediately upon occurrence. Remember, judgment calls cannot be protested.
- All players rostered who played in the 2023 Co-ed Tough Turkey Volleyball Tournament match will receive a tournament shirt. Please include shirt size on the tournament roster.





- All start times on the schedule are merely estimates. Teams should be ready to play immediately after the proceeding match even if it is
 running ahead of the estimated start time. If a team is not present for the match, after the 10-minute warm-up period, their 1st game shall
 be forfeited. If another 10 minutes pass, the team shall forfeit their 2nd game, even if the games are running ahead of estimated start times.
 This rule also applies to teams scheduled to officiate.
- There will be no shuffling of teams unless deemed necessary by the Tournament Director.
- Practice balls and Game balls are provided every year. If both teams agree, you may use a ball from either opponent to play. If the teams do not agree, you will use the provided game ball for play. Please ask staff if you do not know where the balls are located. Do you prefer a type of ball you wish we provided for the game ball? We are open to suggestions. Please leave the information on the survey we provide every year for your feedback. Survey information can be found in the final bullet below.
- Please self-regulate those on your roster playing Saturday and Sunday. If someone is playing Sunday that isn't on your roster, we will have issues. We will only enforce this if the person is NOT on your roster. Please make sure they are on your roster and there will not be any issues.
- The award for the 2023 1st and 2nd play teams will be Volleyball Equipment as requested by YOU!
- We will have a photographer around on the first day to take pictures of your team and take photographs of the play. We will show those pictures on the TV in the hospitality room on Sunday.
